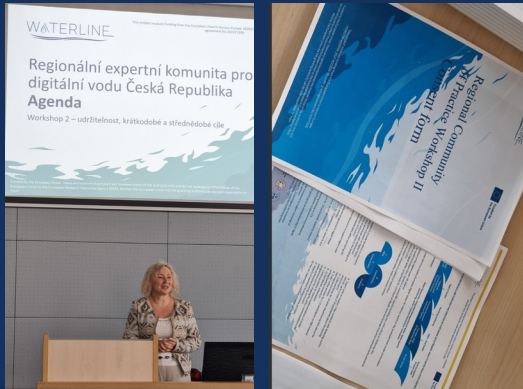

- Public Private Partnerships (PPPs) = 6 key principles: **accountability, transparency, integrity, stewardship, efficiency, and leadership**

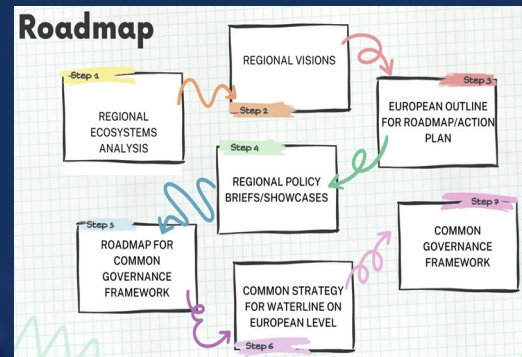

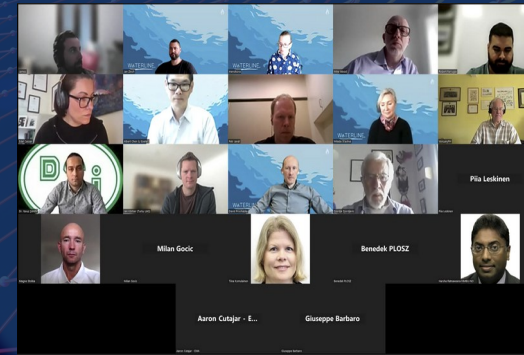
